Eligibility

- Applicant must reside in Vanderburgh county and/or primary activities are in Vanderburgh county.
- Applicant must plan to major in Consumer & Family Science or a related field at an accredited college or university. Related fields include: Dietetics, Restaurant and Institutional Management, Interior Design, Fashion Merchandising, Child Development, etc.
- Applicant must demonstrate scholastic ability, as demonstrated by having at least a 3.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 scale).
- Applicant must possess interpersonal communication skills as demonstrated in an interview.
- Applicant must participate in community activities such as church, school, etc.
- Applicant must disclose financial need (if all other qualifications are equal).

Scholarship Conditions

- The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000 per year, renewable for 3 additional years (for a total of 4 consecutive years).
- Scholarship recipient must maintain a 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4.0 scale) in order to renew the scholarship each year. If the grade point average falls below 3.0, student will forfeit scholarship for the following year, but will be eligible for reinstatement when grade point average returns to 3.0.
- Scholarship recipient must demonstrate completion of at least 12 credit hours each semester in order to renew for the next year.
- Scholarship is payable upon completion of registration each fall.

References

- Each application must be accompanied by 3 letters of reference. These may come from a 4-H leader, an Extension Homemaker, a teacher, school guidance counselor, mentor, or other community leaders.

Application Procedure

- Complete and sign application.
- Include a current, official transcript.
- Provide three sealed letter of references.
- All applications materials must be submitted TOGETHER to the address listed above by April 1.

Award

- The scholarship recipient will be announced at the annual Extension Homemakers Achievement Program in May.
