Eligibility

- Applicant must reside in Vanderburgh county and/or primary activities are in Vanderburgh county as of their senior year in high school.
- Applicant must plan to major in Consumer & Family Science or a related field at an accredited college or university. Related fields include: Dietetics, Restaurant and Institutional Management, Interior Design, Fashion Merchandising, Child Development, etc.
- Applicant must demonstrate scholastic ability, as demonstrated by having at least a 3.0 grade point average based on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must possess interpersonal communication skills as demonstrated in an interview.
- Applicant must participate in community activities such as church, school, etc.
- Applicant must disclose financial need (if all other qualifications are equal).

Scholarship Conditions

- The scholarship will be a one-time amount of \$1,500.
- Winners of this non-renewable scholarship can apply again provided they maintain:
 - A 3.0 grade point average (based on a 4.0 scale) during their previous year of college.
 - Demonstrate completion of at least 12 credit hours each semester.
- Scholarship is payable upon completion of registration in the fall.

- Each applicant must be accompanied by 3 letters of reference. These may come from a 4-H leader, an Extension Homemaker, a teacher, a school guidance counselor, a mentor, or other community leader.

Application Procedure

- Complete and sign the application.
- Include a current, official transcript.
- Provide three sealed letters of reference.
- All application materials must be submitted together to address listed above on or before April 1.

Award

- The scholarship recipient will be announced at the annual Extension Homemaker Achievement Program in May.
